CORE Articulation Agreement (2022-2023)

Students who have previously earned an academic associates degree from Contra Costa College at the time of matriculation, will be required to take EC 2000 at Dominican University of California, but all other CORE requirements will be considered met through the AA

Note: All course are 4 units at Dominican University of California. Contra Costa College 3 unit courses may meet our CORE requirement but not earn 4 units
